4-days of intensive training,

workshops, face-to-face meetings and **personalised feedback**, this programme gives you the possibility of creating a strong network and integrating sustainable strategies in your artistic practice.

The Summer Training for Artists, developed by The Artist and the Others, provides concrete knowledge, essential skills, and reallife connections in order for you to extend your network. It is a **unique** opportunity to build a professional backbone for a career in the arts.

Recently graduated artists, and those who are at the beginning of their artistic career, can easily fall into a socalled "black hole". It is a precarious period, leading 90% of graduated artists to abandon their artistic careers.

LET'S ADDRESS THE PROBLEM.

The cause is a lack of knowledge about the dynamics of the art world, practical skills and professional connections. This training programme offers artists an extensive range of tools, concrete knowledge, essential skills & real-life networking opportunities, increasing confidence by building a strong professional backbone for a sustainable. long-lasting career in the arts.

WHAT DOES THE PROGRAMME COVER?

WHAT DOES IT INCLUDE?

The 2025, newly updated 6th edition of the training programme includes more than 30 hours of professional hands-on workshops, presentations, discussions, visits to cultural spaces & interactive activities.

Each participant will receive a **toolkit** in advance, including a detailed description of the content of the programme, relevant information, and useful links which can be used and referred back to at any stage of their careers.

Held in Munich, a city known for its dynamic cultural landscape, the training offers participants the opportunity to immerse themselves in a fresh art world.

CENTRAL TOPICS

 \rightarrow How to navigate the artworld(s).

→ Reflecting on how to develop a sustainable practice (meeting with galleries, off spaces, curators and other artists).

→ How to select residencies,
exhibitions and grants applications
(including a section for parent-artists).

→ Building a meaningful portfolio & clear artist statement.

→ How to introduce **Care** within your practice and projects.

The program provides concrete practical skills bridging the gap between art education and the professional world, empowering artists to navigate their careers with confidence.

IMPORTANT NOTE

The critical topics taught in this programme are **not** included in the curricula of (most) Art Academies **but they are essential for an artistic career**.

WHAT IS THE FOCUS?

This Summer Training specifically adddresses the obstacles that artists face at the start of their careers.

AS A PARTICIPATING ARTIST YOU WILL GET:

→ Tailored feedback, based on your artistic practice;

→ Face to face meetings with gallerists, curators and art workers with many years of experience;

→ Personalised feedback on your artist statement, portfolio, and artist residency applications;

→ Live meetings with local & international professionals from the field;

\rightarrow Extra PORTFOLIO NIGHT:

in September/October, where participants will present their final, revised portfolio (either in person or online, TBC) to different experts, gallerists, curators, and art workers who will provide individual feedback and advice.

→ Once completed, participants have 2
extra hours of INDIVIDUAL COACHING
(to be used in the 12 months after
completing the programme) which can
support you in further developing your
artistic career.

WHAT MAKES THE SUMMER TRAINING OFFER UNIQUE?

Via real-life connections and highly interactive activities, the Summer Training offers individualised feedback and advice, allowing participants to receive guidance specific to their artistic journey.

You will have the chance to

participate actively, ask experts questions, receive answers & engage with other artists and professionals.

In this way, we facilitate **direct**

connections with gallerists, curators, and other art professionals, fostering a supportive network that can lead to meaningful collaborations and opportunities.

A HOLISTIC APPROACH TO SUSTAINABLE ARTISTIC PRACTICES

While many programs focus on technical skills or professional networking, this programme emphasises the importance of **integrating self-care and sustainable strategies** into artistic practices. This approach addresses the **emotional and physical well-being of artists, acknowledging the challenges of freelancing and the need for resilience in the art world.**

TO BE CONSIDERED, YOU MUST BE:

A recently graduated, emerging or parent artist who wants to

→ Gain new professional knowledge and skills in the art field and its intersections;

→ Develop a better understanding of possible strategies and opportunities to further develop your career;

→ Build a solid professional backbone and a strategic plan which can help take the next steps in your career;

→ Explore and get to know the international and local art scene in Munich;

 \rightarrow Connect with curators and gallerists;

 \rightarrow Incorporate **Care** within your artist practice, and in your porjects.

→ Become inspired by a "new" cultural scene, and meet other artists from all around the world.

You will leave with new and updated professional knowledge, practical skills, a greatly expanded professional network, an action plan for the next steps in your professional life and longlasting connections to inspiring artists from around the world.

THE PROGRAMME IS OPEN TO 15 ARTISTS FROM MUNICH AND ABROAD.



HOW CAN YOU APPLY?

Artists will be selected by the following jury members: Jessica Capra - Director at The Artist and the Others (Maastricht/Munich), Radmila Krstajic/Sophie Slade -PLATFORM (Munich), Dona Daria team (Rotterdam).

Each application will be considered individually, and evaluated according to quality, motivation and the artist's possibility of benefitting from the programme.





DAY 1 INTRODUCTION: STARTING AN ARTISTIC CAREER + FAIR PRACTICE IN THE ARTS

On day 1, we will start with an **introduction and presentation** on behalf of The Artist and the Others and PLATFORM Munich. This will be followed by a **peer networking activity** among participating artists.

After this, there will be a workshop, 'How do you develop a sustainable career as an Artist?', led by Jessica Capra (Curator, Director & Head of Projects - The Artist and the Others), about starting a career as an artist which will provide an overview of what must be considered when laying the foundations for a sustainable career in the arts. The day will end with an open discussion, also led by Jessica Capra, on fair practices in the arts, fair pay guidelines, and artists' rights.

DAY 2 WRITING A CLEAR AND EFFECTIVE ARTIST STATEMENT + PORTFOLIO REVIEW

On day 2, there will be two practical workshops led by Mariana Sesma (Curator, Artist and Cultural Manager). The first workshop, 'How to write a clear and effective Artist Statement', will look into the dos & don'ts, writing styles, and frameworks. You will also be supported in the creation of an updated artist statement which truly reflects your practice.

After this, in the **workshop 'How to build a strong Portfolio'**, we will look at what experts expect from your Portfolio, how to adapt it and what to include. The day will end with a **Portfolio Review** with experts, gallerists, and curators, where you will **receive individual, specific feedback on your own Portfolio.**

PORTFOLIO REVIEW WITH EXPERTS

DAY 3 BEING AN ARTIST AS A PROFESSION + NAVIGATING THE ART WORLD

On day 3, we will start with a **warm welcome and have an introductury Q&A** to look back on the topics covered in the first two days. After this there will be two workshops by **Emilia Telese (PhD Doctorate, Artist and Lecturer)**, who has extensive knowledge of the art world, experience working independently and with institutions, and has researched the social value and the individualisation of the artist.

In the morning, in the **workshop 'Being an Artist, as a Profession'**, we will look at how artists can find representation in the art world, the relationships which exist between artists, society, markets and the world economy, and whether you can live of art alone. In the afternoon, in the **workshop 'How to navigate the art world & create a sustainable workflow of projects'**, we will dive in to how to deal with institutions, build professional relationships, manage a career and create a workflow of funded projects while managing insecurity.

DAY 4 ARTIST RESIDENCIES + CHALLENGES + NETWORKING EVENT

On day 4, after a warm introductory moment, we will have a workshop by **Jessica Capra (Curator, Director & Head of Projects - The Artist and the Others)**. In this workshop, **'Artist Residencies and how to write successful applications'**, we will look at artist residencies through a critical lens, touching on how they can be a tool, opportunities in Bavaria & beyond, how to navigate the options, funding and documents.

The workshop will be followed by a **discussion on the challenges faced by artists**, and how they can be tackled or dealt with. The 4-days will end with an open networking event.^{*} This will include a **panel discussion on the importance of supportive networks in the arts and a networking activity** for participating artists, alumni and external experts, gallerists, and curators.



PLATFORM is a contemporary art space and qualification project for artists, curators and those involved in the culture sector in the city of Munich. Since 2009, it has been funded by the Münchner Beschäftigungs- und Qualifizierungsprogramm (MBQ) of the Department of Labour and Economic Affairs. The project is supported by Münchner Arbeit, a nonprofit GmbH. It is unique in Germany for its combination of a demanding curatorial programme, gualifications for the cultural labour market, and the provision of studio spaces for visual artists and creative people.
